

# Goblirsch, Clobes lead the way for AJ girls

Kayla Goblirsch, Jr., NUC

A four-time state qualifier, Goblirsch finished eighth at the Class A state girls' golf meet with a two-day score of 176, earning a medal for the first time in her career. She finished the season with an average of 42 over nine holes and she took first in the section tournament this past year.

Nadine Clobes, Sr., MVL

Clobes had a season to remember for the Chargers, finishing ninth overall at the Class A state meet this year with a two-day score of 179. She averaged a 45.7 over nine holes and helped lead the Chargers to a second-place finish at the Section 2A meet this year.

Morgan Engholm, Jr., Cedar Mountain

Engholm placed fourth in Section 2A and she also competed at the Class A state meet, finishing 51st overall with a 103. Her season average was a 51 and her best rounds were 46 and 48 at the Section 2A meet in North Mankato. She was also All-Conference in the Tomahawk this year.

Abbie Riederer, Jr., MVL

Riederer qualified for the state meet this year, finishing with a two-day score of 223 to finish in a tie for 69th overall. She averaged a 53.7 over nine holes this past year for the Chargers.

Liz Schwint, So., SEU

Schwint was a state tournament qualifier this year, finishing 62nd overall with a two-day total of 216. She averaged 54 over nine holes this year and she looks to make a repeat trip back to Becker next year for another state meet.

Paige Dreckman, Jr., NUHS

Dreckman was one of New Ulm's more consistent golfers this year. She averaged a 50 on the season and will be one of the leaders next year for the Eagles.
