

Haala, Winkelmann lead All-Journal boys' golfers

Logan Haala, Sr., NUC

Haala qualified for the Class A state tournament in 2019 and 2021, finishing sixth overall this year with a two-day score of 151. He averaged a 40 over nine holes this year for the Greyhounds.

Mavrick Winkelmann, Sr, Springfield

Winkelmann was the Tomahawk Conference Player of the Year and he finished tied for sixth at the state meet with a two-day total of 151. He also finished fifth in state as a sophomore and he had a nine-hole average of 37.

Carson Erickson,

So., SEU

Erickson helped lead the Sleepy Eye United golf team to a third-place finish at the Class A boys' golf meet this year with a 39.5 average over nine holes. The Section 2A individual champion finished 21st overall in his first state appearance with a two-day total of 159.

Toby Weiss, Sr., SEU

Weiss averaged 40.8 over nine holes this year and helped Sleepy Eye United take third at the Class A state golf meet. He finished third at the Section 2A meet and finished 22nd overall at the state meet with a two-day score of 160.

Logan Netzke, Sr., SEU

Netzke averaged 41.2 over nine holes for Sleepy Eye United and he finished fifth at the Section 2A meet. He's a four-time state tournament qualifier and he finished 28th overall at the state meet with a 162.

Christopher Thram, Jr., Springfield

Thram finished seventh at the Section 2A meet this year with a 161 and he finished 26th at the state meet with a 161. He averaged 42 over nine holes this year.
